WHAT IS LENT?

Lent is the annual period of Christian observance that precedes Easter. The dates of Lent are defined by the date of Easter, which is a moveable feast, meaning that it falls on a different date each year.



Lent starts on Ash Wednesday (6 March) & its observance lasts for 40 days, mirroring the 40 days that Jesus spent fasting in the wilderness before starting his ministry. It can also be seen to mirror the 40 hours that Jesus spent in the tomb prior to his resurrection.

Lent is a penitential period, involving the dual disciplines of abstinence and fasting. During Lent many Christians commit to fasting or giving up certain foods, habits or luxuries - for example meat, cakes and sweets, alcohol, smoking - for its duration (the money saved is often then donated to charity). This is done both as a form of penitence and as a spiritual tool to tame the body and 'sharpen the spirit' for prayer, reflection and contemplation in preparation for the celebration of Easter.

A SEASON OF PRAYER & FASTING

The *World Day of Prayer* service also fall at this time of year, and was hosted by Red Cliffs Church of Christ on Friday evening.

Thanks to all who assisted in the service preparation and particularly to Tanika who spoke on the night. All of the Red Cliffs churches were represented & the Project Offering raised over \$350.
